



1.1 Know Your Continents!


Instructions:

1.2 Which Direction Should I Go?


Instructions:

Emphasising the lesson on different continents of the world map.










2.1 Lead The Way!




2.3 Oceans of the World

3.2 The Continen-talk

Instructions:

Divide students into groups and give each group a continent. Get them to discuss what is unique about that particular continent.

What students will learn:

Maximising knowledge of the different continents that shape the world, increasing general knowledge in students

Example:

Asia

- 1. Largest continent.
- 2. Highest and lowest points on the surface of the Earth.

Africa

- Numerous climate area (Northern temperature to Southern temperature zones.
- 2. Home to hyenas, cheetahs and lions (largest combination).





3.3 Country Talk


Instructions:

Ask students to draw their favourite country flag or country name and to explain why it is their favourite. Explanation can be done by drawing or words.

What students will learn:

Identifying and acknowledging emotions and encouraging open communication in providing solutions.

Dear educators,


Stickers give students

'Keep it up!'.


