OVERVIEW & PURPOSE


Promotes the value of friendship and helping each other out. Teaches students the good that comes out of being inclusive and not leaving someone out based on differences.




Engaging children with creative play and questions that involve participation throughout the process.






1.1 Colour Me Animal!


1.3 Kraw!








3.2 Arrr!
